

*Each of the townships involved has a website that can be very instrumental in leading a powerful protest against this line invading these locations. Within the next week or two the trustees, state officials, and other significant individuals will be meeting to discuss alternative routes, the impact of this line on the welfare of the people in the area, and the toll on the environment. The information and decisions that come out of these meetings is crucial to each individual that wants to protest the proposed line in either one of these corridors.*

*I propose that each township publicize on it's website the information from this meeting/s identically plus the names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses of each organization and individual that will be instrumental in deciding where this transmission line is placed.*

*By communicating to all of us with ONE VOICE, the trustees of Thompson, Montville, and Huntsburg will empower us to stop this transmission line from invading either one of the Clay or 528 corridors.*
